## FUNERAL SERVICE POLICY

Policy applies to all members of Emmanuel  
Missionary Baptist Church

An immediate family member should contact **Sis. Blonnie Burroughs, Church Secretary at 317/546-8131** to notify the church upon the death of a church member or their immediate family member. Soon after the message is received, you will receive a telephone call from the Bereavement Ministry. Before making final funeral arrangements you must check with the church regarding the availability of the Church, date and time of the proposed funeral service. Funerals for non-members at Emmanuel require the approval of Pastor Webster. All funerals will have one viewing which will be held prior to the service, thereafter there will be no additional viewing. Funerals scheduled on a Saturday will begin at 11 AM. ***Fraternal or civil rites are not included as part of the funeral homegoing worship service at Emmanuel and these organizations should pay tribute to the deceased at another location.*** A floral arrangement and a condolence will be provided for all deceased members or their immediate family member from the church. For funerals held at Emmanuel the Culinary Ministry will provide a meal for the deceased family members for up to 75 people. Additional meals can be provided at a nominal cost for over 75 people but it must be approved by Pastor Webster and scheduled in advanced with the Culinary Ministry Leader, Deacon James Davis before the repast occurs.
